

Facts about the South Green Roof

- The South Green Roof is over 8,000 sq ft (743 square meters)



- The roof has a storm-water management system that uses water stored under the pavers to water the gardens
- All paths are accessible with 4 planters designated exclusively for barrier-free gardening
- Our Green Roof provides green space for the other species such as birds and butterflies
- The Green Roof lowers the roof temperature which extends the life of the roof, reduces the heat island effect and cleans the air!

Please Keep Our Garden Roof Safe and Clean!

- **Smoking is not permitted on the Green Roof**
- Please use the garbage receptacles located at the north (by the Party Room) and south (by the back stairs) end of the roof
- There are 3 fire extinguishers located on either side of the Party Room and by the south staircase
- **Absolutely nothing is to be thrown over the edge of the green roof walls e.g., Cigarette butts, bottle caps etc.**
- Tables, chairs and planters are not to be moved; they are set up to accommodate people in wheelchairs and scooters. Fire exits and aisles must remain clear at all times



Reminders about the Use of the Green Roof

- The roof is open from 5:00 a.m. until 11:00 p.m.
- **Speakers are not to be used on the roof deck**
- **Members cannot book the Green Roof. It is open to all members during the times above. Please be considerate of others!**
- Outside guests are only permitted on the roof deck when accompanied by members. Children and youth (under the age of 16) are the responsibility of their parent and/or guardian and must be supervised
- Please respect the beautiful gardens
- The center part of the roof garden is a pond system and forms part of the irrigation system. It is not intended to be walked on or played in. Please do not throw anything into the area (such as coins etc.)
